A RECORD YEAR FOR REQUESTS

We are pleased to announce that our not-for-profit organization received and processed a record 1.67 million underground utility locate requests from professional excavators and homeowners in 2021. Our Joliet-based, notification system distributed more than 9.7 million requests. Compared to the previous year, these totals represent increases of 2.48% and 2.68%, respectively.
