KEEPING HOMEOWNERS SAFE

(*They do not locate privately installed or owned lines.*) State law requires you—the person actually doing the digging—contact JULIE at least 3 days before you plan to put a shovel in the ground.

JULIE personnel are not locators and will never visit your property.
