It's a FREE service.



TOGETHER, WE CAN PREVENT ACCIDENTS

JULIE connects homeowners like you with utility companies so they can mark where their underground utility lines are buried on your property. *(They do not locate privately installed or owned lines.)*

State law requires the person actually doing the digging contact JULIE at least 3 days before planning to put a shovel in the ground.

Prior to starting your project, make sure all utility companies have responded by the dig start date and time indicated on your ticket:

- Check JULIE's online Positive Response system
- Look for paint, flags and marks that indicate the location of underground lines on your property

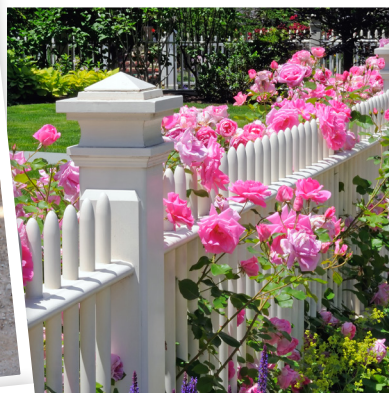
JULIE personnel are not locators and will never visit your property.
